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## NZS 3631:1988 New Zealand timber grading rules

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### Description

This Standard establishes visual grading rules for the selection of timber into quality classes.

The four types of grades specified are:

1. appearance grades, for finishing and other uses;
2. cutting grades, for short clear lengths;
3. structural grades, primarily for strength and
4. stiffness; and box grades.

For approval of species and grades for particular building applications refer to NZS 3602.
