- (a) to wiring and equipment which is used for any purpose other than the consumption of electricity in premises owned or occupied by an Electricity Supply Authority; or
- (b) to equipment belonging to the Supply Authority in consumers premises; e.g. the service line or underground service cable, service protective devices, metering equipment and the like.
