This clause ensures people can move safely into and from buildings. Access routes include the approach to the main entrance of a building, corridors, doors, stairs, ramps and lifts. It sets out requirements for: slip resistance, stair treads, handrails and cross falls people with disabilities to carry out normal functions within buildings the movement, loading and parking of vehicles.

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
